The Church grants this month to The Virgin Mary to know her and love her more

- Reflect on the main virtues Of the Virgin Mary.

Mary was a woman with a deep life of prayer, she lived always close to God. She was a humble woman, that is, simple; she was generous, she forgot herself to give herself to others; She had great charity, loved and helped everyone equally; She was helpful, she attended to Joseph and Jesus with love; she lived with joy; she was patient with her family; she knew how to accept God's will in his life.

- Live a real and true devotion to Mary.

It is about striving to live as her children. This means:

1. Look at Mary as a mother:

Talk to her about everything that happens to us:
The good and the bad.
Know how to go to her in everything moment.

2. Show her our love:

Do what she expects of us and remember her throughout the day.

3. Trust fully in her:

All the graces that Jesus gives us pass through the hands of Mary, and it is she who intercedes with her Son for our difficulties.

4. Imitate her virtues:

This is the best way to show her our love.

- **Pray as a family the prayers especially dedicated to Mary.**

The Church offers us beautiful prayers such as the Angelus (which is customary to pray at noon), the Regina Coéli (Queen of Heaven), the Consecration to Mary and the Rosary. Various Marian prayers such as: Blessed be your Purity, Hail Mary, Hail, Remember, Under your Protection, etc.

- We can meditate on how Maria behaved for example during:

Visiting Her cousin Isabel

The Birth of Christ

The Presentation of the Child Jesus in the temple

The Child Jesus lost and found in the temple

The Wedding at Cana

Mary at the foot of the cross.

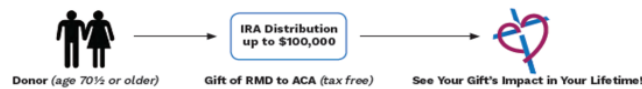

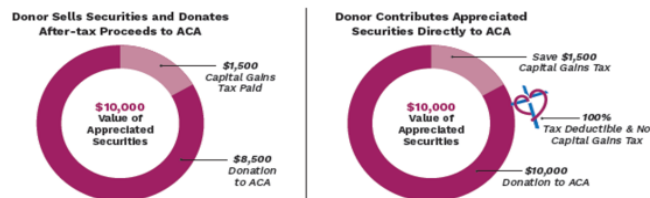
